How to apply:

Make sure you can meet the University requirements for admission ()https://www.ualberta.ca/graduate-studies/prospectivestudents/international-admissions-protocol/international-academicrequirements including for English (https://www.ualberta.ca/graduatestudies/prospective-students/international-admissions-protocol/englishlanguage-proficiency)

- Go to the list of researchers who currently have positions available at <u>https://intlgradpositions.med.ualberta.ca/</u>
- Identify a small number of faculty members and contact them by e-mail and
 - \circ $\:$ state your desire to apply for a CSC PhD or PDF award $\:$
 - \circ $\,$ explain why you are interested in doing research with them
 - provide them with a current CV
- Most faculty members will request a video conferencing interview. Be prepared to:
 - o describe your previous research experience
 - \circ $\,$ explain why you are interested in the research
 - $\circ \quad \text{ask questions about the research}$
 - inquire about the entrance requirements of the graduate program, including English examination requirements (if you are applying to the PhD program)
- Once you have found a faculty member who is willing to be a supervisor:
 - PDFs can apply for the CSC applications with their confirmed supervisor
 - PhD students need to apply to the graduate program to which the supervisor belongs
 - After receiving a letter from the Faculty of Graduate Studies & Research offering admission or provisional admission into the program, the CSC PhD application can be completed

Note: The Faculty of Graduate Studies is currently allowing Duolingo scores to be submitted to meet their language requirement, however some programs may not accept these scores.
